PROMOTING PARENTAL BONDING, EARLY LITERACY, AND FAMILY-CENTERED CARE

A QUALITY INNOVATION PRESENTED BY:

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BACKGROUND

- The Special Care Baby Unit (SCBU) Little Library initiative is founded on acknowledging the significant influence of parental bonding on the health and happiness of newborns and their families.
- This project aims to establish a supportive atmosphere in response to comprehending the difficulties families encounter in the SCBU, as revealed through a concept analysis of parental anxiety in this setting.
- Six attributes were identified: unfamiliar environment, emotional reaction, fear of loss, uncertain outcome, lack of information and control, and discomfort.
- Notably, empirical studies underscore the profound benefits of early reading and interactive engagement in nurturing the cognitive development of preterm and unwell infants.¹



NEONATAL HOSPITALIZATION CHALLENGES

- Parental Anxiety: Parents of infants in the SCBU often experience heightened anxiety due to the unfamiliar environment and medical complexities.³
- Parental bonding: Separation and medical interventions can hinder the development of strong emotional bonds between parents and their infants.²
- Family-centered care: Balancing medical needs while involving families in the care process can be challenging in a SCBU setting.⁴



AIM AND OBJECTIVES

 To alleviate parental anxiety, promote parent-infant bonding, encourage early engagement in reading, and provide holistic support for the well-being of our tinniest community members.



DESCRIPTION OF THE INNOVATION

- This innovation lies in curating age-appropriate, durable, wipeable books and audio-books, that are now available to parents on SCBU, creating an intimate and personalized reading environment.
- Infection prevention and control measures.
- The Little Library provides a calming and supportive environment for shared reading experiences directly at the cot/incubator side. This fosters a nurturing connection between parents and their newborns.



IMPLEMENTATION OF THE INNOVATION

- Funded by the Nursing Midwifery Planning and Development Unit.
- Dedicated space for the 'little library' was designed within the SCBU.
- Multidisciplinary collaboration was fostered to curate appropriate books/resources.
- The SCBU Little Library was incorporated into parental orientation sessions as part of the nurturing care.
- Informative resources and baby reading diaries were developed for comprehensive parental support.
- Observation and feedback are used to facilitate ongoing improvements and ensure the sustained effectiveness of the initiative.
